

MENDIANG DR GOH SWEE HENG (1971-2006)



Pada 7 hb September 2006 (Khamis). Mendiang Dr. Goh Swee Heng telah meninggal dunia di daerah Xienkhoung, Laos. Beliau telah mengalami kemalangan di Sg. Mendiang Dr. Goh Swee Heng dilahirkan 6 hb Julai 1971 di Bukit Mertajam Pulau Pinang merupakan seorang yang ceria, kuat berkerja dan tekun dalam sesuatu perkara. Pada tahun 1996 hingga 1999, beliau melanjutkan pelajaran peringkat sarjana di UKM dengan menjadi pembantu penyelidik di bawah projek IRPA dan seterusnya dilantik sebagai tutor Program Geologi pada tahun 2000. Pada tahun 2001, beliau melanjutkan pelajaran peringkat Doktor Falsafah dalam bidang mineral ekonomi dan perlombongan di Universiti Malaya, Kuala Lumpur dan memprolehi Ijazah Kedoktoran pada 2006 dan dilantik sebagai pensyarah Program Geologi pada tahun yang sama.
